## **ORDINANCE NO. 3896**

An ordinance imposing a moratorium on the issuance of permits and/or licenses for massage parlors, spas, or salons in all zoning classifications.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that the moratorium hereby imposed shall be effective until November 30, 2018, or until additional action is taken by the Slidell City Council regarding the subject hereof, whichever is sooner.
