ORDINANCE NO. 3902

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 6 Animals, by replacing Section 6-29(a) in its entirety.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that Chapter 6 Animals, Section 6-29(a) be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- "(a) (1) All dogs and cats shall be kept from running at large at all times.
- (2) Dogs traveling in the back of a pickup truck shall be tethered at all times.
- (3) Electronic fences, incorporating the use of electrical charges as a means of restraint of an animal within a yard-like perimeter, may only be used as a secondary means of restraint and not as a replacement for actual, physical fencing or an enclosure.
- (4) Failure of owners to prevent their dog(s) or cat(s) from running at large shall constitute a misdemeanor.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
