7 An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter
8 6 Animals, by replacing Section 6-29(a) in its entirety.

9 NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that Chapter 6 Animals, Section 6-
10 29(a) be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

12 “(a) (1) All dogs and cats shall be kept from running at large at all times.



14 (2) Dogs traveling in the back of a pickup truck shall be tethered at all
15 times.

16
17 (3) Electronic fences, incorporating the use of electrical charges as a
18 means of restraint of an animal within a yard-like perimeter, may only be
19 used as a secondary means of restraint and not as a replacement for actual,
20 physical fencing or an enclosure.

21 (4) Failure of owners to prevent their dog(s) or cat(s) from running at
22 large shall constitute a misdemeanor.

23 BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective upon
24 adoption.
