ORDINANCE NO. 3913

An ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 2, Administration, Article I, by changing Section 2-1 and renumbering the remaining Sections under Article I, In General.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council desires to establish the criteria for naming part of a public building after a living person; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statute 42:267 allows for the naming of a part of a public building after a living person; and

WHEREAS, the City Council and Mayor acknowledge that the naming of a part of a public building is a rare and significant dedication to a special person(s) in our community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby agrees that it shall require a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Council to adopt an ordinance naming a part of a public building after a living person; and

WHEREAS, in order for an application to be considered by the Mayor and Slidell City Council, a clear demonstration of a person's commitment to the City including, but not limited to, the commitment of time, talent and/or treasures that serve to improve and enhance the City of Slidell must be set forth; and

WHEREAS, only elected officials of the City of Slidell may submit an application for the naming of a part of a public building; and

WHEREAS, the term "time" used herein is defined as a period no less than ten (10) years; and

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WHEREAS, the term "talent" used herein is defined as arts, music, leadership, or other definable act to be considered by the City; and

WHEREAS, the term "treasure" is defined as a financial contribution to the City in the form of cash and/or movable and/or immovable property; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council and Administration does not intend for this Ordinance to signal that such action by the City is to be taken lightly and that strict review, consideration and deliberation shall be equally applied to any application submitted.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 2 Administration, Article I, by changing Sec. 2-1 as follows:

Sec. 2-1. General Rules.

- (a) Application.
- 1. Application must be submitted by an elected official of the City of Slidell.
- 2. All Applications shall be subject to strict review, consideration and deliberation by the Mayor and City Council.
- 3. Application must demonstrate the following:
 - a. Clear demonstration of a person's commitment to the City including, but not limited to, the commitment of time, talent and/or treasures that serve to improve and enhance the City of Slidell must be set forth; and
- 4. An application shall require a criminal background check be performed by the City Attorney's Office.

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- (b) Definitions.
- 1. The term "time" used herein is defined as a period no less than ten (10) years.
- 2. The term "talent" used herein is defined as arts, music, leadership, or other definable acts to be considered by the City.
- 3. The term "treasure" is defined as a financial contribution to the City in the form of cash and/or movable and/or immovable property.
- (c) Vote:
- 1. It shall require a two-third (2/3) vote of the City Council to adopt an ordinance naming a part of a public building after a living person.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council

that all Sections in Chapter 2, Article 1, In General, be renumbered as follows:

- Section 2-1 General Rules.
- Section 2-2 City hall and auditorium named.
- Section 2-3 Old Town Hall named.
- Section 2-4 Police department building named.
- Section 2-5 Slidell city court named.
- Section 2-6 Third Street tennis courts named.
- Section 2-7 Heritage Park named.
- Section 2-8 2-20 Reserved.
- Section 2-21 Mardi Gras declared holiday.
- Section 2-22 Smoking in municipal buildings.
- Section 2-23 Rules, regulations, and prohibition against smoking,

the use of tobacco and/or tobacco products and/or vapor products.

- Section 2-24 City archives.
- Section 2-25 Immovable property inventory.
