WHEREAS, City desires to recognize a local couple who have committed their lives and resources towards the improvement and enhancement of cultural arts in our community; and

WHEREAS, Ronnie and Gardner Kole started Jazz on the Bayou and have raised \$1.5 million for non-profits directly benefiting the City of Slidell, Easter Seals, STARC, Safe Harbor, Tammany Trace, and the City of Slidell Cultural Arts; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Gardner Kole is a founder of the Slidell Arts Guild; and WHEREAS, Mrs. Kole was owner of the first ballet studio in Slidell, teaching and introducing countless area children to dance arts; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ronnie Kole is a distinguished Member of the Louisiana Music Hall of Fame; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ronnie Kole has performed for six U.S. Presidents and Pope John Paul II; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ronnie Kole is one of five musicians included in the New Orleans Musical Legends Park; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ronnie Kole helped organize both the first New Orleans

Jazz Fest and the French Quarter Festival; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ronnie Kole is a Winner of Chevalier of Arts and Letters, the highest honor the French Govt. bestows to a person in the arts for their artistic contributions to the British Empire; and

WHEREAS, City is blessed to have this couple call Slidell Home; and

WHEREAS, Slidell City Council and the Administration of the City of Slidell, desire to honor Ronnie and Gardner Kole with the naming of the stage at Heritage Park for their many contributions to the Cultural Arts in Slidell and around the world.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Chapter 2, Administration, Article I, by adding a new section as follows:

Sec. 2-7.1 Amphitheatre Stage in Heritage Park named.

The amphitheater stage at Heritage Park is hereby named the "Ronnie and Gardner Kole Stage" in recognition of their many contributions to the Cultural Arts in the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
