17 fixed by the Mayor of Slidell, who shall also establish method of payment and other
18 specifications for bidders, including deadline for removal.

21 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that surplus Police Department vehicles may
22 be subject to sale by auction to other law enforcement agencies or political subdivisions at
23 a time, date and place determined by the Mayor or his designee who shall also establish
24 method of payment and other requirements for bidders including deadline for removal.
