7 An ordinance for the City of Slidell which shall set forth and designate the
8 adjusted millage rates as required by Paragraph B of Section 23, Article VII of the
9 Constitution of Louisiana, for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Police
10 Department, Garbage Collection, Sewer System, Public Works, General Government, as
11 well as providing for the payment of interest and principal on outstanding general
12 obligation bonds, in said City for the fiscal year 2021.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council of the City of
14 Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that, in consideration of the adjustment of
15 millage rates due to reassessment, there is hereby levied an aggregate tax of 26.09 mills
16 on the dollar upon all property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in
17 said City, according to the assessment roll of said City, in the calendar year 2020.

18 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said aggregate tax is
19 composed of the following individual authorized tax levys:

20 A tax of 4.88 mills for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenues
21 to pay and defray the expenses of the municipal government and for the general municipal
22 and local purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2021, as authorized by
23 Louisiana Constitution Article VI, Section 27.

24 A tax of 2.88 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the
25 Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2021, as
26 authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana on
27 November 19, 2013.

21 public works within the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for fiscal year 2021, as authorized by the
22 special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana on April 4, 1981.
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25 A tax of 2.20 mills for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay
26 interest and maturing bonds for the 2010 General Obligation Bonds for the City of Slidell,
27 Louisiana, for fiscal year 2021, as authorized by a special election held October 17, 2009,
28 and by a Resolution of the Mayor and Council Members of the City of Slidell, Louisiana,
29 passed on the 28th day of July, 2009.
