6 **ORDINANCE NO. 4041**

7 An ordinance to extend a time-limited moratorium on the issuance of annual  
8 permits for new mobile food service operators within the City of Slidell.  
9

10 WHEREAS, Sections 8-61, *et seq.* of Article III of Chapter 8 of the Code of  
11 Ordinances of the City of Slidell provide for a City permitting process for mobile food  
12 service, as defined therein, on both a single event and an annual basis; and  
13  
14

15 WHEREAS, a mobile food service, by its nature, should operate as a transitory  
16 presence for food service; and  
17

18 WHEREAS, the City requires additional time to further study the effects of an  
19 annual permitting scheme for mobile food services, particularly as they relate to otherwise  
20 applicable zoning restrictions within the City, the impact on City commerce, the potential  
21 extended or permanent presence of mobile food services in a single location, and the aims  
22 of the comprehensive master plan being developed by the City; and

26 WHEREAS, in Ordinance No. 4005, the City promulgated a time-limited  
27 moratorium on the issuance of certain annual mobile food service permits through June  
28 30, 2021; and

31 WHEREAS, the extension of the time-limited moratorium on the issuance of  
32 new annual mobile food service permits is advisable to allow the City time to complete its  
33 study; and

36 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does  
37 hereby extend its moratorium on the issuance of any new annual permit for mobile food
