WHEREAS, on August 25, 2020, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 3996, which placed a time-limited moratorium on the review, construction, permitting, and approval of new multi-family dwellings within the City of Slidell, subject to certain allowances, as set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, the City continues in its desire to ensure responsible development and construction throughout the City, consistent with a comprehensive master plan, and requires additional time to further evaluate what impact additional multi-family dwellings within the City footprint may have on City roads, drainage ways, water and sewage infrastructure, and the ability of City government to meet demand for services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby extend the moratorium on any review, construction, permitting, or approval of new multi-family dwellings within the City of Slidell, as set forth in City Ordinance No. 3996, through February 25, 2023.

ORDINANCE NO. 3996

An ordinance to impose a time-limited moratorium on the review, construction, permitting, and approval of new multi-family dwellings within the City of Slidell.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is in the process of developing a comprehensive master plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has a number of multi-family dwellings, such dwellings being defined for the purpose of this ordinance as a building with three (3) or more living units; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to ensure responsible development and construction throughout the City, consistent with a comprehensive master plan, and to further evaluate what impact additional multi-family dwellings within the current City footprint may have on City roads, drainage ways, water and sewage infrastructure, and the ability of City government to meet demand for services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby impose a moratorium on any review, construction, permitting, or approval of new multi-family dwellings within the City of Slidell; it being understood, however, that nothing in this ordinance shall prohibit (i) the commencement of construction and completion of any multi-family dwelling projects that completed a development meeting with the City of Slidell Planning Department on or before August 25, 2020 and that receive all requisite building permits and approvals on or before December 31, 2020; (ii) the completion of any multi-family dwellings already physically under construction at the time of the adoption of

this ordinance, when such construction had begun and is completed pursuant to all required approvals from relevant authorities; or (iii) the renovation of any existing multifamily dwellings if such renovation does not expand the size or number of living units of such units being renovated, and such renovation is begun and completed with all required approvals from relevant authorities.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this moratorium shall be effective immediately upon adoption of this ordinance and shall run for eighteen (18) months from the date of its adoption or until the adoption of the City's comprehensive master plan by the City of Slidell Planning Commission, whichever comes first, unless earlier terminated or further extended.
