## **ORDINANCE NO. 4067**

An ordinance authorizing a salary adjustment for the City's director of finance.

WHEREAS, in the revised Revenue, Expense and Capital Budget for fiscal year 2021-2022 (first supplemental budget), the City made appropriations sufficient to support a salary adjustment of three percent (3%), on an annualized basis, for the City's director of finance (see p. 2 of first supplemental budget); and

WHEREAS, City administration has provided appropriate justification for granting a proposed salary adjustment to the City's director of finance in said amount, consistent with Section 21-1 of the City's Code of Ordinances.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that it approves the granting of a salary adjustment to the City's director of finance, in the amount of three percent (3%), on an annualized basis, setting her annual base salary at \$119,575.00, exclusive of any car allowance to be integrated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that this ordinance (including the salary adjustment authorized herein) shall take effect February 14, 2022.
