7 A resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an Agreement with the
8 Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (LA DOTD) for improvements at
9 the Slidell Airport.

10 WHEREAS, Act 451 of the 1989 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature
11 authorized the financing of certain airport improvements from funds appropriated from the
12 Transportation Trust Fund; and

14 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has requested funding assistance from the LA
15 DOTD to re-stripe Runway 18/36; and



18 WHEREAS, the stated project has been approved by the Louisiana
19 Legislature and the LA DOTD is agreeable to the implementation of this project and
20 desires to cooperate with the City of Slidell according to the terms and conditions identified
21 in the attached Agreement; and




