4 **RESOLUTION R05-06**

5 A resolution of the Slidell City Council endorsing the “**Clean City Campaign**” as
6 a City-sponsored event.

7 WHEREAS, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 3165 on February 10,
8 2004, which required that any events sponsored by the City of Slidell be approved jointly
9 by the Mayor and the Council; and

11 WHEREAS, the procedure involves the completion of a “City-Sponsored
12 Event” application by the entity seeking sponsorship; and

14 WHEREAS, the form is then sent to various department heads as
15 determined by the Administration in order to provide internal cost estimates and availability
16 of labor and accommodations for said event; and


18 WHEREAS, the form is then forwarded to the Mayor for his approval or
19 denial; and

22 for consideration by Resolution.
