RESOLUTION R05-08

A resolution authorizing the extension of sewer and water lines beyond the City limits.

WHEREAS, Parish President Kevin Davis has requested that the St. Tammany Parish Airport Maintenance Barn on Grantham College Drive be connected to the City of Slidell's water and sewer system.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that:

- Pursuant to Ordinance Section 2-35, the extension of City water and sewer services to the St. Tammany Parish Airport Maintenance Barn on Grantham College Drive is hereby approved; and
- 2. Water Connection: The cost for the water tap and meter would be the only expense for connection to the water system. This cost will depend on the size connection that is required.
- 3. Sewer Connection: The cost for the sewer connection would be \$500 for the tap. The site also requires a sewer pump station to connect to the City's sewer force main running in front of the property. This will be done at the St. Tammany Parish Government's expense.
- 4. The City will provide the water tap and the sewer tap off of the existing lines.

 The cost for having the work done from within the Maintenance Barn site to the roadway would be the responsibility of the St. Tammany Parish Government.

5. The St. Tammany Parish Government will not incur charges for the first 16,000 gallons/month of water and sewer usage. Above that level, charges will be incurred at the out-of-city rate.
