6 A resolution by the Slidell City Council supporting the application of grant  
7 funds from the Slidell Rotary District 6840 Simplified Grant Program for its project entitled  
8 ***“Ending Litter in Slidell - Changing the Culture.”***

9 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell, with the support of Mayor Ben Morris, the  
10 Slidell City Council, and the Slidell Beautification Committee, has enacted new litter  
11 ordinances and has renewed efforts to clean up the City; and

14 WHEREAS, the Slidell Beautification Committee is currently working toward  
15 winning the “Cleanest City Contest” to be judged in April 2005; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, the Slidell Beautification Committee is working with schools in  
18 the Slidell area and sponsors the “Cleanest School Contest” each year; and

19  
20 WHEREAS, this pilot project ***entitled “Ending Litter in Slidell - Changing***  
21 ***the Culture”*** would entail working with selected elementary schools in an educational anti-  
22 litter program; and

25 WHEREAS, the District 6840 Simplified Grant funds would be used to  
26 purchase educational materials, cleanup supplies, special rewards and marketing supplies  
27 (i.e. tee shirts, magnets, bumper stickers, etc.) to be used to support classroom instruction;

32 WHEREAS, the three main approaches to solving the Slidell litter problem are  
33 Education, Enforcement and Cleanups; and

35 WHEREAS, with our pilot program we will try to change the culture by  
36 educating our elementary school children; and
