
9 WHEREAS, the Louisiana Legislature in its recent special session provided
10 for alternative methods of assessing property for ad valorem tax purposes in the aftermath
11 of Hurricane Katrina; and

13 WHEREAS, in order to have the option of choosing between the alternative
14 assessment methods a resolution by the Slidell City Council is required to be sent to the
15 Louisiana Tax Commission.

18 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of
19 Slidell that it intends to consider having lands and property located within the City limits of
20 Slidell assessed and ad valorem taxes collected pursuant to LSA-R.S. 47:1978.1C which
21 provides for the prorating of the taxes for the Year 2005.
