## **RESOLUTION R06-16**

A resolution extending the moratorium on the issuance of certain alcoholic beverage licenses in all commercial zoning districts.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council adopted Resolution R05-38 on December 7, 2005, placing a moratorium on the issuance of certain alcoholic beverage licenses in all commercial zoning districts; and

WHEREAS, said moratorium expires April 25, 2006.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby extend the moratorium on the issuance of certain alcoholic beverage licenses in all commercial zoning districts which sell alcoholic beverages by the drink. This moratorium shall not apply to restaurants, cafeterias or tax exempt organizations as defined in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, Section 4-22(3)(e) and Section 4-22(3)(f) respectively. This moratorium shall expire on October 31, 2006.
