RESOLUTION R06-18

A resolution of the Slidell City Council requesting that the Civil Service Board evaluate and recommend to the City Council changes to the pay plan, as required to resolve systemic problems that adversely contribute to employee hiring and retention, primarily in the lower pay grades.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is currently experiencing great difficulties in hiring and retaining occupation types such as, laborers, equipment operators, police officers, and communication officers; critical to providing services to the public; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has hired "difficult-to-fill" positions at up to step 3 provided that funds are available, however, the ordinance authorizing such hiring expires June 30, 2006; and

WHEREAS, some of the City of Slidell's difficulty results from the inability to hire new employees and recognize an individual's education, experience and training, above the basic job requirements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council requests the Civil Service Board review the pay plan, particularly, with respect to the "difficult-to-fill" and retain positions, and compare these areas of the pay plan to employment norms and competitive salaries and benefits in appropriate markets. This evaluation should concentrate on the classified positions since this is where the difficulties are centered.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that administration be permitted to hire persons at steps greater than step one provided that the applicant's education, experience, and training warrants such action.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the evaluation be completed by December 1, 2006 and that interim reports be issued to the City Council on or about September 1, 2006 and November 1, 2006.
