4 **RESOLUTION 06-19**

6 A resolution imposing a moratorium on the issuance of permits or licenses
7 relative to pain management clinics.

8 WHEREAS, in the past the City of Slidell has experienced the adverse
9 effects of clinics which prescribe pain medications without valid medical reasons therefor;
10
11 and

13 WHEREAS, such prescriptions cause or continue drug addictions by citizens
14 of Slidell and others who are present within the City; and

15
16 WHEREAS, the City desires to study the issue of pain management clinics
17 with regard to possible regulation thereof.

19 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that:

20
21 1. A moratorium is hereby imposed prohibiting the issuance of any permits or
22 licenses or any other action by the City which would allow the location or conducting of any
23 business such as pain management clinics, pain clinics, pain centers, pain rehabilitation
24 centers and other such healthcare facilities within the City of Slidell; and

27 2. This moratorium hereby imposed shall be effective until June 30, 2007, or
28 until additional action is taken by the Slidell City Council regarding the subject hereof,
29 whichever is sooner; and

32 3. Businesses in the nature of pain management clinics which are currently and
33 validly operating within the City are not subject to this moratorium.
