## **RESOLUTION R06-26**

A resolution requesting that the City Administration place a nine-month moratorium on the issuance of new occupational licenses to providers of ambulance services within the City of Slidell so that all aspects of minimum licensure requirements may be studied.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council reserves the right to extend or prematurely end this moratorium upon the adoption of minimum services and technology standards regarding licensing providers of ambulances in the City limits of Slidell.
