Thanks for your interest in Amateur Radio and for the great support the City of Slidell has provided the Ozone Amateur Radio Club over the years. The use of the Slidell Municipal Auditorium for our Annual Ham Fest for the last 15 years has greatly benefited our club membership and increased community awareness of the services Amateur Radio provides our community.

Our fee and deposit for the use of the Municipal Auditorium has been \$300 per year. City Ordinance No. 3407 Sec. 10-28 increases our Deposit to \$1000 and our fees to \$925 for our Friday set up and Ham Fest on Saturday. Our Ham Fest has cleared an average of \$950 over the last 15 years.

The Ozone Amateur Radio Club has been privileged to support the City of Slidell and local community in the following events:

- Provided Amateur Radio Operators at the National Weather Office and North Shore Regional Medical Center for the last 10 years. These operators (W5PY and N5PGO) were very active during Katrina and recognized by the National Hurricane Center in Miami and American Radio League for their efforts.
- Provided Amateur Radio Operators at Slidell Memorial Hospital and Louisiana Heart Hospital.
- Provided Amateur Radio Operators for the Slidell E.O.C.
- Conducted 14 Training Sessions for the City of Slidell Employees in order for them to obtain their Amateur Radio License.
- Conducted 4 Test Sessions for the City of Slidell Employees sessions resulted in 16 Licensed Operators for the City.
- Set up the City of Slidell Repeater for 2 meter and 440 operations. The city now has access to Emergency Amateur Radio Frequencies (including HF) during disasters.
- Assisted in setting up Amateur Radio Operations at the St. Tammany Parish E.O.C. in Covington.

All of these services are offered at no cost and will continue to be provided to the City of Slidell by the Ozone Amateur Radio Club. We are a non-profit organization and take pride in voluntary service to our city and local community.

In order to continue our Annual Ham Fest at the Municipal Auditorium, we are requesting to be considered a Public Group Type for City sponsored events and listed as such on Page 2 Line 5 of Ordinance No. 3407.
