7 A resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of Slidell to enter into a design
8 agreement with Sizeler, Thompson, Brown Architects to produce all design drawings,
9 documentation, and specifications to solicit bids for construction of Slidell City Government
10 Building #1.

11 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is planning to restore its drastically damaged
12 administrative buildings by building one to three new administrative offices; and

13
14 WHEREAS, Slidell City Government Building #1 will be built in place of the
15 old Finance Building at 2045 Second Street, and will total approximately 23,000 sq. ft.; and

16
17 WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Sizeler, Thompson, Brown Architects to
18 design the Slidell City Government Complex; and

20 WHEREAS, Sizeler, Thompson, Brown Architects have presented tentative
21 plans to the City Council on Slidell City Government Building #1; and

23 WHEREAS, a Public Notice soliciting comments from the public on the
24 proposed Slidell City Government Building #1 has been published three times in the
25 Official Journal, affording citizens the opportunity to present written and verbal comments
26 to the Council; and

29 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council has received a preliminary funding source
30 for the project.

33 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does
34 hereby authorize the Mayor to enter into a design agreement to enter into a design


