8 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell was devastated by Hurricane Katrina; and

10 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council created the position of a Main Street
11 Coordinator; and

13 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has recently adopted new Design Guidelines
14 for the Olde Towne Preservation District and the Fremaux Corridor developed by the
15 Tulane Regional Urban Design Center; and

17 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council appropriated start-up funds for the
18 creation of the Camellia City Farmer's Market every Saturday in Olde Towne; and

20 WHEREAS, Keep Slidell Beautiful, an affiliate of Keep America Beautiful, has
21 helped the Olde Towne revitalization efforts by placing and maintaining planter trashcans,
22 hanging baskets, wooden benches, and conducting once-a-month cleanups using
23 Community Service workers; and

25 WHEREAS, participating in the Main Street Program, will enable the City to
26 continue the rebuilding efforts in Olde Towne and assure its continued success.

28 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does
29 hereby support the efforts of the City of Slidell and the Olde Towne Task Force to include
30 Slidell in the Main Street Program.


