RESOLUTION R09-02

A resolution extending the moratorium on the sale and construction of modular housing within the City of Slidell.

WHEREAS, the popularity of modular housing has recently been increasing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell's zoning code and building code currently do not specifically address certain issues associated with modular housing; and

WHEREAS, those issues require analysis to determine whether the City's codes require amending; and

WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana is considering legislation which may impact modular housing within the City of Slidell; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 3490, dated August 12, 2008, placed a moratorium on the sale and construction of modular homes until January 31, 2009 to allow Administration time to recommend changes to building and zoning codes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that an extension of six (6) months on the moratorium is hereby imposed on the sale and construction of modular housing structures within the City of Slidell.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the moratorium imposed hereby shall expire on July 31, 2009.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council reserves the right to extend or prematurely end this moratorium upon the adoption of changes to the building or zoning codes.
