A resolution ordering and calling a special election to be held in the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, to authorize the incurring of debt and issuance of bonds and the levy of a special tax therein; making application to the State Bond Commission in connection therewith; and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), that:

SECTION 1. Election Call. Subject to the approval of the State Bond Commission, and under the authority conferred by Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, Sub-Part A, Part III, Chapter 4, Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, the applicable provisions of Chapter 5 and 6-A of the Louisiana Election Code, and other constitutional and statutory authority, a special election is hereby called and ordered to be held in the Parish on SATURDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2009, between the hours of six o'clock (6:00) a.m. and eight o'clock (8:00) p.m., in accordance with the provisions of La. R.S. 18:541, and at the said election there shall be submitted to all registered voters qualified and entitled to vote at the said election under the Constitution and laws of this State and the Constitution of the United States, the following propositions, to-wit:

SUMMARY: TO AUTHORIZE \$10,000,000 OF 20-YEAR GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF SLIDELL FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING, CONSTRUCTING AND IMPROVING DRAINAGE, STREETS AND BRIDGES, SAID BONDS TO BE PAYABLE FROM AD VALOREM TAXES.

Shall the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), incur debt and issue bonds in the amount of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000), in one or more series, to mature twenty (20) years from date thereof, with interest at a rate not exceeding nine percent (9%) per annum, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing and improving drainage, streets and bridges; which bonds will be general obligations of the City and will be payable from ad valorem taxes to be levied and collected in the manner provided

by Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974 and statutory authority supplemental thereto?

SECTION 2. Publication of Notice of Election. In accordance with La. R.S. 18:1285, a Notice of Special Election shall be published in the St. Tammany News, a newspaper of general circulation within the City, published in Covington, Louisiana, and being the official journal of the City, once a week for four consecutive weeks, with the first publication to be made not less than forty-five (45) days nor more than ninety (90) days prior to the date of the election, which Notice shall be substantially in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and incorporated herein by reference the same as if it were set forth herein in full.

SECTION 3. Canvass. This Governing Authority shall meet at its regular meeting place, Slidell City Council Chambers located in City Hall at 2055 Second Street, Slidell, Louisiana, on **TUESDAY**, **NOVEMBER 10**, **2009**, at **6:30 P.M.**, and shall then and there in open and public session proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the results of the said special election, pursuant to § 1292 of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended.

SECTION 4. Polling Places. The polling places set forth in the aforesaid Notice of Special Election are hereby designated as the polling places at which to hold the said election in accordance with Section 1286 (A) or §1286.1, as the case may be, of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and the Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners, respectively, will be the same persons as those designated according to law in accordance with §1286 (A) or Section 1286.1, as the case may be, of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended.

SECTION 5. Election Commissioners; Voting Machines. The officers designated to serve as Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners pursuant to Section 4 hereof, or such substitutes therefor as may be selected and designated in accordance with La. R.S. 18:1287, shall hold the said special election as herein provided, shall make due returns of said election for the meeting of the Governing

Authority to be held on Tuesday, October 27, 2009, as provided in Section 3 hereof, and that the compensation of said officers shall be fixed at the sum provided by law.

SECTION 6. Authorization of Officers. The Council Administrator of the Governing Authority is hereby empowered, authorized and directed to arrange for and to furnish to said election officers in ample time for the holding of said election, the necessary equipment, forms and other paraphernalia essential to the property holding of said election and the President, Vice President and/or Council Administrator of the Governing Authority are further authorized, empowered and directed to take any and all further action required by State and/or Federal law to arrange for the election, including but not limited to, appropriate submission to the Federal Department of Justice under Section 5 of the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.

SECTION 7. Furnishing Election Call to Election Officials. Certified copies of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State, the Commissioner of Elections, the Clerk of Court and Ex-Officio Parish Custodian of Voting Machines of St. Tammany Parish and the Registrar of Voters of St. Tammany Parish, as notification of the special election, in order that each may prepare for said election and perform their respective functions as required by law.

SECTION 8. Application to State Bond Commission. Application is made to the State Bond Commission for consent and authority to hold the special election as herein provided, and in the event said election carries for further consent and authority to issue, sell and deliver the bonds and to levy and collect the special tax provided for therein. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the State Bond Commission on behalf of this Governing Authority, together with a letter requesting the prompt consideration and approval of this application.

SECTION 9. Employment of Bond Counsel. A real necessity is hereby found for the employment of special counsel in connection with the issuance of the aforesaid bonds, and accordingly McGlinchey Stafford, PLLC, Bond Counsel, is hereby employed and requested to do and perform comprehensive legal and coordinate professional work with respect to the issuance of the aforesaid bonds of the City for the

purposes stated hereinabove. Said Bond Counsel shall prepare and submit to this Governing Authority for adoption all of the proceedings incidental to the authorization, issuance, sale and delivery of the bonds, shall counsel and advise this Governing Authority as to the issuance and sale of the bonds, and shall furnish their opinion covering the legality of the issuance thereof. The fee of special bond counsel in connection with the issuance of the aforesaid bonds of the City is hereby fixed a sum not to exceed the maximum fee allowed by the Attorney General's fee guidelines for comprehensive legal and coordinate professional services in the issuance of general obligation bonds, based on the amount of said bonds actually issued, sold, delivered and paid for, plus "out-of-pocket" expenses. Bond Counsel fees may be paid from the proceeds of said bonds and shall be contingent upon the issuance, sale and delivery of said bonds. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be submitted to the Attorney General of the State of Louisiana for his written approval of said employment and of the fee herein designated.

SECTION 10. Employment of Financial Advisor. A real necessity is hereby found for the employment of a financial advisor to the Governing Authority in connection with the issuance of the aforesaid bonds and therefore the firm of Government Consultants of Louisiana, Inc. is hereby engaged. The fee to be paid for such services may be paid from the proceeds of the bond and shall be in an amount agreed to by the Governing Authority.
