4 **RESOLUTION R09-26**

5 A resolution by the Slidell City Council reiterating and emphasizing its intent  
6 regarding off-street parking requirements.

7  
8 WHEREAS, the off-street parking requirements outlined in the Code of  
9 Ordinances, Appendix A, Zoning, Section 4.2, have been interpreted differently by two City  
10 departments; and

12 WHEREAS, changes to off-street parking requirements are being studied;  
13

16 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council's intent of the ordinance was to allow  
17 parking of vehicles on hard surfaces only and not in the grass in front of homes; and  
18

19 WHEREAS, the Council wants to preserve the esthetics of its neighborhoods  
20 with uncluttered green space.  
21

22 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it  
23 hereby reiterates its intent of the off-street parking requirements is as follows:

25 Section 4.2. Off-street parking requirements.  
26


27 Parking on the grass in front yards or in front of homes is not allowed.  
28  
29 Parking surfaces shall be hard-surfaced only with either concrete or asphalt.


30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it desires the
