## **RESOLUTION R10-01**

A resolution imposing a moratorium on metal buildings in commercial zones.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council is considering amending Appendix A Zoning, Sec. 2.22 Supplementary district regulations, part 2.2216, relative to exterior façade building materials; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to study various types of building materials so that they may be compatible with architectural and aesthetic goals of the City; and

WHEREAS, a moratorium on metal buildings in commercial zones within the City is required during the time period of the study;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that a six month moratorium is hereby imposed on the issuance of building permits for all buildings in commercial zones within the City which will employ the use of metal as exterior façade material.
