A resolution extending the contract with Acadian Ambulance Service.

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2009, the Slidell City Council adopted Ordinance No. 3527 which authorized the Mayor to execute a contract with Acadian Ambulance Service, Inc. (hereinafter "Acadian") for the provision by Acadian of Emergency and Non-Emergency Services (hereinafter "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the said Contract was executed by Mayor Morris on May 6, 2009 and by Acadian on May 12, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the term of the Contract was for a period of one year beginning on June 1, 2009 and ending on May 31, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Contract provided that the parties have the option to agree upon five (5) additional one year renewal terms by mutual written consent; and

WHEREAS, the Quality Assurance Panel established pursuant to paragraph M of the Contract has reviewed Acadian's performance obligations under the Contract and found that such obligations have been met or exceeded during the initial term of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to extend the term of the Contract; and
WHEREAS, Mayor Morris has written a letter to Acadian agreeing to four (4)
additional one year terms so as to make the total term of the Contract five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council concurs with the extension of the Contract for four additional one year terms which establishes May 31, 2014 as the ending date of the Contract.
