A resolution authorizing the Mayor of the City of Slidell to execute a Legal Services Contract with the Thornhill Law Firm relating to the BP Oil Spill in the Gulf of Mexico on April 20, 2010.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has submitted a claim for damages against BP as a result of the oil spill in the Gulf of Mexico on April 20, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Parish of St. Tammany and other governmental jurisdictions have hired the Thornhill Law Firm (Thornhill) to represent them in the Multidistrict Litigation (Litigation) pending in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for filing a claim in the Litigation is April 20, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Thornhill has proposed a Legal Services Contract (Contract) to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Contract presents no monetary risk to the City in the event of an unfavorable outcome of the litigation; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to select Thornhill to represent it.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that pursuant to Charter Section 4-02(D) the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a Legal Services Contract with the Thornhill Law Firm to represent the City in the Multidistrict Litigation No. 2179 pending in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of

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Louisiana relating to the BP Oil Spill in the Gulf of Mexico on April 20, 2010, a copy of which Contract is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
