WHEREAS, Slidell adopted the Home Rule Charter in 1977; and;

WHEREAS, the Home Rule Charter, Section 2-01, states "The legislative power of the City shall be vested in a Council consisting of nine (9) members elected as follows," and;

WHEREAS, the Home Rule Charter, Section 2-05B, limits the authority of the Council to "involve themselves in any manner in the appointment, removal, direction or supervision of any City administrative officer or employee", and;

WHEREAS, the Home Rule Charter, Section 3-01, states "The mayor shall be the chief executive officer of the City and shall exercise general executive and administrative authority over all departments, offices and agencies of the City, except as otherwise provided by this charter," and;

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2011, an interoffice memorandum was issued by the Chief of Staff to the individual members of the City Council which establishes the policy of "Any and all communication with any Administrative employee shall be through my office."

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Slidell City Council does hereby request an Attorney General's opinion verifying the memorandum is a valid exercise of executive authority under the Slidell Home Rule Charter.
