RESOLUTION 11-18

A resolution imposing a moratorium on the issuance of permits or licenses relative to commercial body art facilities.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell adopted Ordinance 3591, which states "No person other than a licensed person under R.S. 40:2832 shall cause any indelible mark or figure to be fixed upon the body of a human being or to pierce the human being in any manner as further set further in R.S. 20:2832"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has employed a consultant to perform a comprehensive study of the City's Zoning Ordinances and recommend necessary revisions to such ordinances.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that:

- A moratorium is hereby imposed prohibiting the issuance of any permits or licenses or any other action by the City which would allow the location or conducting of any business such as a commercial body art facility within the City of Slidell; and
- 2. This moratorium hereby imposed shall be effective until June 30, 2012, or until additional action is taken by the Slidell City Council regarding the subject hereof, whichever is sooner.
