8 Scouts and therefore is a commitment you make and complete as an individual; and

10 WHEREAS, by earning the Girl Scout Gold Award you will be joining the
11 ranks of generations of young women who have made a difference both locally and
12 globally, you are in an exceptional position to take action and make the world a better
13 place; and

15 WHEREAS, there are over 2 million Girl Scouts in the United States, but only
16 about 4,000 receive the Gold Award each year; and

18 WHEREAS, to receive this award Ms. Kent had to create and implement a
19 sustainable and ongoing community service project that demonstrated leadership and
20 planning abilities, and promoted positive values, personal and spiritual growth, and
21 community service; and

23 WHEREAS, a minimum of 135 hours were required for the seven steps of the
24 Gold Award process; and

26 WHEREAS, Ms. Kent, an 11-year Girl Scout, is the daughter of Lynn and
27 Chris Kent and was a member of Slidell Troop 63. Ms. Kent, a 2010 Northshore High
28 School graduate, attends Rhodes College, majoring in mathematics. Her project was to
29 replace aging benches used in the mess hall and unit houses of Girl Scout Camp


4 Whispering Pines. With the help of her adviser, John Cousins, she was able to build new
