## **RESOLUTION R14-08**

A resolution urging the Louisiana Congressional Delegation to Sponsor and Support HR 3789 and HR 3790 Relative to Armed Forces Retirement Compensation Benefits.

WHEREAS, Section 403 of the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2013 required reduction of any periodic increase in retired pay for those retired members of the armed services, including those retired because of combat related disability, under the age of 62; and

WHEREAS, HR 3789 would amend title 10, United States Code, to exempt the retired pay of certain disabled veterans from the reduced adjustment of retired pay and retainer pay amounts for retired members of the Armed Forces under age 62, to prevent any adverse impact of the reduced adjustment on annuities under the Survivor Benefit Plan based on retired or retainer pay, and for other purposes; and

WHEREAS, HR 3790 would repeal the annual adjustment of retired pay and retainer pay amounts for retired members of the Armed Forces under age 62; and

WHEREAS, wounded and disabled service members, as well as other retired members, are dependent upon their benefits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell supports efforts to reinstate full retirement compensation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it hereby urges the Louisiana Congressional Delegation to sponsor and support HR 3789 and HR 3790.
