7 A resolution of the Slidell City Council authorizing Mayor Freddy Drennan to
8 enter into the PetSmart Pop-Up Park Agreement ("Agreement") between City of Slidell
9 ("City") and PetSmart, Inc. ("PetSmart");

10 WHEREAS, City of Slidell is committed to creating and extending additional
11 services to its citizens; and

12
13 WHEREAS, City desires to provide a dog park for the benefit of its citizens
14 and has commenced construction of a permanent dog park within the boundaries of
15 Fritchie Park; and

18 WHEREAS, PetSmart has a mobile pet "pop-up" park ("**PetSmart PUP**") for
19 use during City's permanent dog park construction; and

22 WHEREAS, PetSmart has agreed, at its expense, to erect and later remove
23 at Fritchie Park the "PetSmart PUP" for use during City's permanent dog park construction;

27 WHEREAS, the term of this Agreement will begin on its Effective Date and,
28 unless sooner amended, terminated or extended as provided in the Agreement, end on the
29 date that is one (1) year later, or the date on which City's authorization to steward the
30 PetSmart PUP at Fritchie Park ends, or the date upon which City's completed permanent
31 dog park is opened to the public, whichever occurs first. City agrees that if the PUP Park
32 is still in place at Fritchie Park upon completion of its permanent dog park, City will make
33 reasonable good faith efforts (but will not be contractually required) to provide a suitable
34 location for relocation of the PUP Park to another park location within City, and cooperate

4 with relocating and reinstalling the PUP Park at such location, at PetSmart's sole expense
5
6 and responsibility; and

7 WHEREAS, the City and PetSmart will each benefit from the construction of
8
9 the PetSmart mobile pet "pop-up" park.

11 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does
12 hereby authorize Mayor Freddy Drennan to enter into the PetSmart Pop-Up Park
13 Agreement between City of Slidell and PetSmart, Inc.
