5 **RESOLUTION R15-04**

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7 A Resolution relative to the construction of a Safe House.

8 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell applied for federal funding through the Federal
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10 Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the design and construction of a community
11 safe house; and

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13 WHEREAS, funding was sought under the Hurricane Gustav disaster
14 declaration, DR-1786-LA; and

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16 WHEREAS, the City's application for funding has been accepted; and

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18 WHEREAS, the Safe House is intended to provide near-absolute life safety
19 protection for an identified population of first responders and other critical/essential services
20 personnel; and

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23 WHEREAS, the Safe House will be constructed on the Public Operations site
24 at 1325 Bayou Lane, will consist of an approximately 4,000 square foot building, and will be
25 protected to a minimum of 24 inches above the 500 year floodplain; and

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28 WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the project is \$1,400,000; and

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30 WHEREAS, the City will be required to meet the required 25% cost share of
31 the project which share will be comprised of non-federal funds, in-kind, or a combination of
32 both; and

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35 WHEREAS, the in-kind aspect of the cost share will include site work done by
36 the City, appraisal cost, survey cost, etc.; and

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4 WHEREAS, the Mayor intends to include in the FY16 budget ordinance an
5 appropriation for the cash aspect of the cost share;
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7 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council supports this project;
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9 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Slidell City Council that the
10 Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all documentation required in order to
11 effectuate the design and construction of the Safe House.
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13 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, by the Slidell City Council, that the Mayor will
14 include in the FY 16 budget ordinance an appropriation for the cash aspect of the cost share.
