7 A resolution accepting and approving the Engineering and Economic  
8 Feasibility Report for Recommended Capital Improvement Program for Roads and  
9 Drainage prepared by the City Engineer and City Director of Finance, showing the  
10 anticipated ad valorem tax revenues required to retire certain proposed general obligation  
11 bonds, all in connection with the scheduled election on April 9, 2016; ordering the filing of  
12 such report; directing the publication of a summary of the engineering and economic  
13 feasibility report in the St. Tammany Farmer sixty (60) days prior to the election of April 9,  
14 2016; and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

15 WHEREAS, the City Engineer and City Director of Finance have prepared  
16 and submitted to this Slidell City Council an engineering and economic feasibility report  
17 (titled "Engineering and Economic Feasibility Report for Recommended Capital  
18 Improvement Program for Roads and Drainage") (the Engineering Report), relating to a  
19 capital improvement program including the issuance of general obligation bonds of the City  
20 of Slidell (the City) to finance capital improvements; and  
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22 WHEREAS, this Slidell City Council desires to approve said Engineering  
23 Report; and  
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25 WHEREAS, Section 5-09 of the Home Rule Charter of the City requires that a  
26 summary of such Engineering Report shall be published in the official journal of the City at  
27 least sixty (60) days prior to the date of the election called for the purpose of incurring  
28 bonded debt, and the Slidell City Council wished to follow such procedure in connection  
29 with calling an election to authorize the issuance of general obligation bonds.  
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31 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, acting as  
32 the governing authority of said City, that:

4           **SECTION 1.** The Slidell City Council, acting as governing authority of the City,  
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6 hereby accepts and approves the Engineering Report, showing the estimated costs and  
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8 project summary prepared by the City Engineer, with schedules showing the anticipated ad  
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10 valorem tax revenues required to fund certain cash expenditures and debt service  
11 expenditures.

12           **SECTION 2.** That is hereby ordered and directed that copies of said  
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14 Engineering Report be filed in the offices of the Slidell City Council to be available for  
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16 public review during regular business hours.

17           **SECTION 3.** This Slidell City Council does further direct the advertisement of  
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19 a summary of the Engineering Report or a summary thereof in the St. Tammany Farmer at  
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21 least sixty (60) days prior to said election of April 9, 2016.

22           **SECTION 4.** This resolution shall become effective immediately.
