6 A resolution providing for canvassing the returns and declaring the result of
7 the special election held in the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, on Saturday, April 9,
8 2016, to authorize the incurring of debt and issuance of bonds therein.

9 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, State of
10 Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the City of
11 Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), that:

13 SECTION 1. Canvass. This Governing Authority does now proceed in open
14 and public session to examine the official tabulations of votes cast at the special election
15 held in the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), on SATURDAY, APRIL 9, 2016, to
16 authorize the incurring of debt and issuance of bonds therein, and said Governing
17 Authority does further proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the result
18 of special election.

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20 SECTION 2. Procès Verbal. A *Procès Verbal* of the canvass of the returns
21 of said election shall be made and a certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the
22 Secretary of State, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, who shall record the same in his office;
23 another certified copy thereof shall be forwarded to the Clerk of Court and *Ex-Officio*
24 Recorder of Mortgages in and for the Parish of St. Tammany, who shall record the same in
25 the Mortgage Records of said Parish; and another copy thereof shall be retained in the
26 archives of this Governing Authority.

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28 SECTION 3. Promulgation of Election Result. The result of said election
29 shall be promulgated by publication in the manner provided by law.

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8 BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED that on Tuesday, April 26, 2016, at six-thirty
9 o'clock (6:30) p.m., at its regular meeting place, the Slidell City Council Chambers, 2045
10 Second Street, Suite 319, Slidell, Louisiana, the Slidell City Council, State of Louisiana
11 (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the City of Slidell, State of
12 Louisiana (the "City"), and being the authority ordering the special election held therein on
13 Saturday, April 9, 2016, with the following members present: Council Members Cusimano,
14 Harbison, Abney, Crockett, Vanney, Newcomb and Borchert.

25 Shall the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), incur debt and issue
26 bonds to the total amount of not exceeding \$12,000,000, to mature not
27 exceeding 20 years from date thereof, with interest at a rate or rates not
28 exceeding 8% per annum, for the purpose of (i) constructing, improving and
29 landscaping public roads, highways and bridges and (ii) constructing,
30 acquiring, extending and/or improving drains, drainage canals and other
31 hurricane protection, flood protection and drainage facilities within the City,
32 title to which shall be in the public, which bonds will be general obligations of
33 the City and will be payable from ad valorem taxes to be levied and collected
34 in the manner provided by Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the
35 State of Louisiana of 1974, and statutory authority supplemental thereto, with
36 an estimated 3.30 mills to be levied in the first year of issue to pay said
37 Bonds?
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4 There was found by said count and canvass that the following votes had been cast

12 forth was duly **CARRIED** by a majority of the votes cast by the qualified electors voting at
13 the said special election held in the City on Saturday, April 9, 2016.

9 Pursuant to the provisions of a resolution adopted by the Slidell City Council,
10 State of Louisiana (the "Governing Authority"), acting as the governing authority of the City
11 of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), on January 26, 2016, NOTICE IS HEREBY
12 GIVEN that a special election will be held within the City on **SATURDAY, APRIL 9, 2016**,
13 and that at the said election there will be submitted to all registered voters in the City
14 qualified and entitled to vote at the said election under the Constitution and Laws of the

23 rate or rates not exceeding 8% per annum, for the purpose of (i)
24 constructing, improving and landscaping public roads, highways and
25 bridges and (ii) constructing, acquiring, extending and/or improving
26 drains, drainage canals and other hurricane protection, flood
27 protection and drainage facilities within the City, title to which shall be
28 in the public, which bonds will be general obligations of the City and
29 will be payable from ad valorem taxes to be levied and collected in the
30 manner provided by Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the
31 State of Louisiana of 1974, and statutory authority supplemental
32 thereto, with an estimated 3.30 mills to be levied in the first year of
33 issue to pay said Bonds?

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
