A resolution authorizing the City of Slidell to prepare and submit an application to the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries (hereinafter the "Department") for Clean Vessel Grant Program Funds, Marine Sanitation Facility Projects, to construct a pumpout station to service Slidell Municipal Marina at Heritage Park; providing for necessary documentation of the need for the construction and providing other matters in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has reviewed the need for public boating facilities and improvements to such publicly owned facilities in the City; and

WHEREAS, the construction of a pumpout station at Slidell Municipal Marina at Heritage Park, located in the City of Slidell, Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana would provide boaters with a convenient alternative to the overboard discharge of sewage; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the total cost of such construction is \$36,300.00 and the local share is \$11,300.00 is from City funds;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council in a public meeting on this 8th day of August, 2017, that the City of Slidell is hereby eligible for assistance and will enter into a project agreement with the Department to provide for said construction on a reimbursement basis, with the City of Slidell providing 25% by appropriations and the Department providing 75% matching funds for work accomplished;
