10 WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau is required by the U.S. Constitution to
11 conduct a count of the population and provides a historic opportunity to help shape the
12 foundation of our society and play an active role in American democracy; and

14 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is committed to ensuring every resident is counted;

18 WHEREAS, federal and state funding is allocated to communities, and decisions
19 are made on matters of national and local importance based, in part, on census data and
20 housing; and

22 WHEREAS, census data helps determine how many seats each state will have in
23 the U.S. House of Representatives and is necessary for an accurate and fair redistricting
24 of state legislative seats, county and city councils and voting districts; and

27 WHEREAS, information from the 2020 census is confidential and protected by
28 law; and

30 WHEREAS a united voice from business, government, community-based and faith-based
31 organizations, educators, media and others will enable the 2020 Census message to reach
32 more of our citizens;
