A resolution of the Slidell City Council authorizing Mayor Greg Cromer to execute a Third Extension and Fourth Amendment to the original Contract by and between the City of Slidell, Louisiana, ("City"), and Global Medical Center, LLC, ("Contractor") for medical services at the Slidell City Jail ("Jail").

WHEREAS, City and Contractor entered into a Contract on December 18, 2014 for the purpose of contracting medical services to inmates at the Jail; and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor entered into a First Extension and Second Amendment to the original Contract on December 18, 2015, extending the contract period until December 18, 2016, and increasing the contract price to \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor entered into a Second Extension and Third Amendment to the original Contract on December 18, 2016 extending the contract period until December 18, 2019 and increasing the contract price to \$ 55,000.00 ("Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor now desire to extend the Amendment by entering into a Third Extension and Fourth Amendment for three years commencing December 18, 2019 and terminating on December 18, 2022, and by setting a fixed contract price of \$59,000.00 per year for each of the three years of the Contract; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby authorize Mayor Greg Cromer to enter into and sign a Third Extension and Fourth Amendment to the original Contract entered into by and between the City of Slidell,

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Louisiana and Global Medical Center, LLC, on the 18th day of December 2014, for the purpose of providing medical services to inmates at the Slidell City Jail.
