WHEREAS, the City has received notice that it is a potential settlement class member in the class action litigation captioned *In Re GSE Bonds Antitrust Litigation*, Case No. 1:19-cv-01704 (JSR) pending in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York (the "Litigation"); and

WHEREAS, the Litigation concerns allegations that defendants, Barclays Capital Inc.; BNP Paribas Securities Corp.; Citigroup Global Markets Inc.; Credit Suisse Securities (USA) LLC; Deutsche Bank Securities, Inc.; First Tennessee Bank, N.A.; FTN Financial Securities Corp.; Goldman Sachs & Co. LLC; J. P. Morgan Securities LLC; Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith Inc.; TD Securities (USA) LLC; Nomura Securities International, Inc.; HSBC Securities (USA) Inc.; Cantor Fitzgerald & Co.; SG Americas Securities LLC; Morgan Stanley & Co., LLC; and UBS Securities LLC, conspired to fix prices of GSE (Government-Sponsored Enterprise) Bond Transactions issued by Federal National Mortgage Association, Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation, Federal Farm Credit Banks, and Federal Home Loan Banks in the secondary market in violation of Section 1 of the Sherman Antitrust Act, 15 U.S.C. §1; and

WHEREAS, the City may have had an investment or other interest in the GSE Bond Transactions at issue in the Litigation and may be included in the proposed

settlement class with settling defendants Deutsche Bank, FTN, and Goldman Sachs and others who may settle; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to file a claim for any potential recovery to which it may be entitled in the Litigation, consistent with the notice of proposed settlements it has received with respect to the Litigation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that the Mayor of the City of Slidell or his designee is hereby authorized to submit any claim forms necessary for the City of Slidell to claim any individual or class recovery it may be entitled to in the Litigation.
