RESOLUTION R20-24

A resolution expressing support for a time-limited moratorium on the review, construction, permitting, or approval of new multi-family dwellings within the City of Slidell.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is in the process of developing a comprehensive master plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has a number of multi-family dwellings, such dwellings being defined for the purpose of this resolution as a building with three (3) or more living units; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to ensure responsible development and construction throughout the City, consistent with a comprehensive master plan, and to further evaluate what impact additional multi-family dwellings within the current City footprint may have on City roads, drainage ways, water and sewage infrastructure, and the ability of City government to meet demand for services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council as follows:

The Slidell City Council expresses its support for a time-limited moratorium on any review, construction, permitting, or approval of new multi-family dwellings within the City of Slidell, subject to an allowance for (i) the completion of any multi-family dwellings already physically under construction, when such construction had begun and is completed pursuant to all required approvals from relevant authorities; and (ii) the renovation of any existing multi-family dwellings if such renovation does not expand the size or number of living units of such units being renovated, and such renovation is begun and completed with all required approvals from relevant authorities.
