RESOLUTION R21-16

A resolution to extend a time-limited moratorium on the issuance of annual permits for new mobile food service operators within the City of Slidell.

WHEREAS, Sections 8-61, et seq. of Article III of Chapter 8 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell provide for a City permitting process for mobile food service, as defined therein, on both a single event and an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, in Ordinance No. 4005, the City promulgated a time-limited moratorium on the issuance of certain annual mobile food service permits through June 30, 2021, which moratorium was subject to extension; and

WHEREAS, the City requires additional time to further study the effects of an annual permitting scheme for mobile food services, particularly as they relate to otherwise applicable zoning restrictions within the City, the impact on City commerce, the potential extended or permanent presence of mobile food services in a single location, and the aims of the comprehensive master plan being developed by the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council as follows:

The Slidell City Council does hereby extend its moratorium on the issuance of any new annual permit for mobile food services within the City of Slidell under Sections 8-61, *et seq.* of Article III of Chapter 8 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, as stated in Ordinance No. 4005, through the end of September 30, 2021, unless earlier terminated or further extended.

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This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
