A resolution extending the time period for the Conditional Use Permit for a veterinary clinic at 59026 Pearl Acres Rd, Slidell, Louisiana (Case CU21-02).

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2021, the Slidell City Council granted a Conditional Use Permit for a veterinary clinic at 59026 Pearl Acres Rd (Ord. 4040); and

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances provides a six-month period of validity for Conditional Use Permits, during which time the owner must make progress on the approved use or the Conditional Use Permit shall become null and void; and

WHEREAS, the period of validity for CU21-02 ends February 11, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the owner has indicated that they have experienced delays but believe they can begin construction in the next six months, and they are requesting that the time period be extended; and

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances provides that the City Council may extend the time period for an additional six months where such extension is deemed reasonably necessary.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby extend the time period for the Conditional Use Permit for a veterinary clinic at 59026 Pearl Acres Rd (Ord. 4040) for an additional six months to end August 11, 2022, subject to the continuation provisions of the Code.
