RESOLUTION R22-07

A resolution designating the number of Carnival/Mardi Gras parades and St. Patrick's Day-related parades allowed in the City of Slidell and providing for related matters in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell's Code of Ordinances, specifically Section 27-166, designates the number of parades allowed in the City during the Carnival/Mardi Gras parade season—subject to certain rules of seniority—and during festivities around St. Patrick's Day, such numbers being subject to modification by Council resolution; and

WHEREAS, parading during these seasons is a long-standing cultural tradition in the City of Slidell and throughout the greater New Orleans area; and

WHEREAS, in order to control the substantial costs incurred by the City related to preparation, staffing, and clean-up for such parades, to minimize the inconvenience to certain businesses and residents along traditional parade routes, to reduce the potential number and length of closures to main road arteries throughout the City, and for other good cause, the City hereby designates the number of Carnival/Mardi Gras parades and St. Patrick's Day-related parades allowed in the City of Slidell.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council as follows:

Effective for the 2023 Carnival/Mardi Gras parade season and for 2023 St. Patrick's Day-related festivities, the number of Carnival/Mardi Gras parades per year within the corporate limits of the City shall be limited to not more than two (2) rolling day parades, three (3) rolling night parades, and one (1) walking day parade; and the number of St.

Patrick's Day-related parades shall be limited to one (1) rolling day parade. Routes and parading dates/times shall be set by the City administration.

First priority for parade permits shall be given to those krewes/organizations who conducted parades during the 2022 Carnival/Mardi Gras parade season and the 2022 St. Patrick's Day-related festivities, respectively, along with the Krewe of Perseus and Krewe de Paws, whose parades were cancelled in 2022, as follows:

• Carnival/Mardi Gras parade season:

Rolling day parades: Krewe of Perseus

Krewe of Dionysus

Rolling night parades: Krewe of Selene

Krewe of Titans Krewe of Poseidon

Walking day parade: Krewe de Paws

St. Patrick's Day-related festivities
 St. Patrick's Day Parade

(Olde Towne Slidell Merchants)

Parade permit applications for the 2023 Carnival/Mardi Gras parade season and for 2023 St. Patrick's Day-related festivities shall be submitted to the City on or before October 14, 2022.

Nothing herein shall be construed to prevent the Krewe of Mona Lisa Moonpie from continuing its permitted walking parade in October of each year.
