RESOLUTION R22-14

A resolution approving and adopting an updated Flood Prevention Outreach Program for Public Information.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has a program called the Community Rating System (CRS) that rewards local governments for exceeding the minimum requirements of the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) by providing a discount on every residential, commercial, and governmental flood insurance policy within a community; and

WHEREAS, as part of the CRS program, a community earns points from the implementation of best practices that mitigate flooding; and

WHEREAS, insurance discounts are derived from Classes assigned by the NFIP based on the total number of points earned by a community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is currently a Class 6, which equates to a 20 percent discount on flood insurance policies city-wide; and

WHEREAS, flood prevention outreach is one of the categories that earns a significant number of points when FEMA calculates a community's CRS score; and

WHEREAS, the Community Rating System allows additional points to be earned when a community creates a formal strategy for outreach through a Program for Public Information; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is a member of, along with its neighboring communities, a regional CRS User Group called the Flood Loss Outreach and Awareness (FLOAT); and

WHEREAS, the FLOAT Group created a PPI in 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell adopted the FLOAT PPI via resolution R16-21 on August 23, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the FLOAT Group has revised the PPI, which must be adopted by a formal vote of the City Council before the PPI will be considered official and the City of Slidell can earn CRS points for its flood prevention outreach.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does approve and adopt the
