

ORDINANCE NO. 1002

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing Body of said municipality, did receive a petition from Marquet Investment Corporation, Ignazio Sansone, Circle R., David R Corporation, Clara Anderton, Billy Tew and Lloyd W. Pierce requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries and

WHEREAS, the said Governing Body did investigate and did find that said petitioners are the sole owners of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits and zone as requested in said petition, by publication in the Slidell Daily Times, April 29th and May 2nd-9th, 1976, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

LOG CABIN SUBDIVISION

Lot 6, Sq. 2, (Marquet Investment Corp.)

Lot 1, Sq. 3, (Ignazio Sansone)

Lots 5 & 6, Sq. 3, (Circle R)

Lot 4, W $\frac{1}{2}$ Lot 5, Sq. 4, (David R Corporation)

N $\frac{1}{2}$ Lot 1, Sq. 4, (Clara Anderton)

Lot 4, Sq. 5, (David H. Willis)

Parcel 242.05 X 150 ft. X 268.04 ft. X 152.4 ft., Section 2-19-14, CB 348-99, CB 499-184, (Billy Tew)

At a corner common to Sections 1-2-11-12, T-9, SR-14, E. go West 3500 ft. to the Southeast corner of Sq. 1, Log Cabin Subdivision to the point of beginning, thence continue along the North edge of the Gause Road right-of-way West 493 ft. thence North 23 degrees, 20 minutes East, 326.7 ft. thence East 363.6 ft. to the Northwest corner of Sq. 1, Log Cabin Subdivision thence South 300 ft. to the point of departure. CB 249-362, (Lloyd W. Pierce)

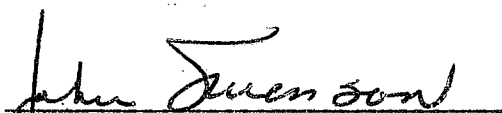
SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana and be zoned C-4, Highway Commercial.

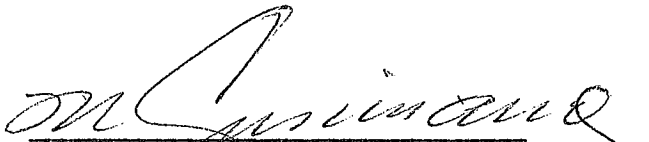
This Ordinance having be submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
