

ORDINANCE NO. 1003-A

An ordinance amending the water and sewer rates charged by the City of Slidell, Louisiana, and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of said City:

SECTION 1. The monthly rate for the service of water to residences within the City limits shall be the sum of Four and 50/100 Dollars (\$4.50) per month. There shall be no free service to any consumer connected to the water system of the City.

SECTION 2. The monthly rate for the collection and disposal of sewage to residences within the City limits shall be the sum of One and 50/100 Dollars (\$1.50) per month. There shall be no free service to any customer connected to the sewer system of the City.

SECTION 3. Where meters are, or shall be, installed, the following monthly rates shall be charged for residential water and sewer service furnished by the City to each property connected to the systems of the City:

First	2,000 gallons	\$2.50 (minimum bill)
Next	3,000 gallons	.40 per 1,000 gallons
Next	5,000 gallons	.38 per 1,000 gallons
Next	10,000 gallons	.36 per 1,000 gallons
Next	20,000 gallons	.34 per 1,000 gallons
Next	60,000 gallons	.32 per 1,000 gallons
Over	100,000 gallons	.30 per 1,000 gallons

Where meters are, or shall be, installed, the following monthly rates shall be charged for commercial water and sewer service furnished by the City to each property connected to the systems of the City:

First	5,000 gallons	\$6.00 (minimum bill)
Next	5,000 gallons	.40 per 1,000 gallons
Next	10,000 gallons	.36 per 1,000 gallons
Next	20,000 gallons	.34 per 1,000 gallons
Next	60,000 gallons	.32 per 1,000 gallons
Over	100,000 gallons	.30 per 1,000 gallons

SECTION 4. The rates herein established have been effective since May 1, 1975, and every user who is now, or hereafter shall be, connected to the system shall be charged the rates hereinabove set forth. All rates heretofore charged are hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 5. The funds realized from the collection of the increase in the flat rates shown (\$2.00 per month to each connection not metered)

shall be set aside in a special fund to be used solely for the purpose of extensions, improvements and renovations to the water and sewerage systems of the City.

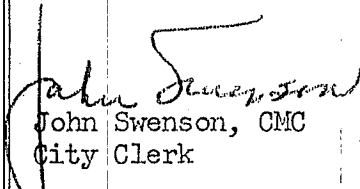
SECTION 6. All laws of the State of Louisiana with respect to connection to available water and sewer mains shall be enforced.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
