

ORDINANCE NO. 1011

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive a petition from Mr. Roger G. Black, Chairman, Board of Trustees, Aldersgate United Methodist Church, requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries and

WHEREAS, the said governing body did investigate and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits as requested in said petition, by publication in the Slidell Daily Times, September 30th, October 7th, 14th and 21st, 1976, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

A certain parcel of land situated in Section 36, Township 8 South, Range 14, East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, being more fully described as follows: From the Southwest corner of said Section 36, go East 469.1 feet to an iron and the point of beginning. Thence North 496.97 feet to an iron; Thence North 23 degrees, 57 minutes, 10 seconds West 154.75 feet to an iron set in the Southerly edge of Robert Road; Thence Northeasterly along said Southerly edge in three courses: North 37 degrees, 23 minutes, 50 seconds East 50.0 feet to an iron; North 38 degrees, 45 minutes, 30 seconds East 100.0 feet to an iron, and North 37 degrees, 08 minutes, 30 seconds East 146.2 feet to an iron; Thence South 8 degrees, 05 minutes, 55 seconds East 881.45 feet to an iron; Thence West 242.7 feet to the point of beginning. Containing in all 3.56 acres of land, more or less.

All in accordance with Survey No. 6115, dated March 3rd, 1976, by Ivan Borgen, C. E.

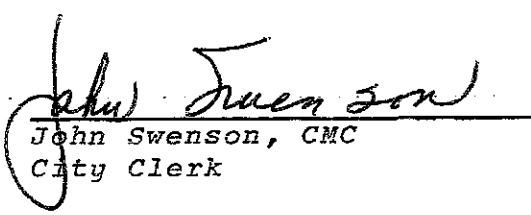
SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana.
