

ORDINANCE NO. 1013

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive a petition from Mr. Frank J. Strecker, requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries and

WHEREAS, the said governing body did investigate and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits as requested in said petition, by publication in the Slidell Daily Times, November 4th, 11th, 18th, 1976, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

That certain tract or parcel of land, lying together with all buildings and improvements thereon, being approximately 1.31 acres of land, lying and being situated in the Southwest corner of the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, 8th Ward, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana and more fully described as follows, to-wit:

From the Southwest corner of said East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ go East a distance of 111.5 feet to a point, thence go North a distance of 515 feet more or less to the Southerly right of way line of the Robert Road, thence go South 48 degrees 00 minutes West a distance of 150 feet and thence go South a distance of 414.4 feet to the point of departure. Containing in all one acre of land, more or less.

All in accordance with Survey No. 4585, dated August 10th, 1964, by J. V. Burkes, C. E.

SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

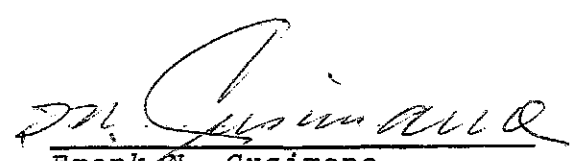
