

ORDINANCE NO. 1029

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, enlarging the boundaries of the said City.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing body of said municipality, did receive a petition from Mrs. Elsie Dolin, requesting the enlargement of the City's boundaries and

WHEREAS, the said governing body did investigate and did find that said petitioner is the sole owner of said property and did give notice of its intention to extend the corporate limits as requested in said petition, by publication in the Slidell Daily Times, March 24th, 31st and April 7th, 1977, and no one requested a public hearing or objected to said petition.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, be enlarged to include the following described property, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southeast Corner of Orange St. Right of Way, thence proceeding 122.85' on Fremaux Ave. to a point, thence proceeding to 148.95' to a point, then West 121.99 to a point, thence South 148.95'

SECTION 2. All of the property described above shall be included in, and become part of, the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

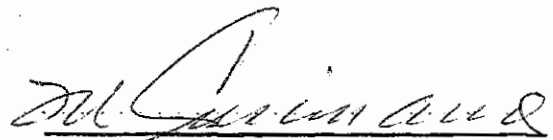
This Ordinance having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:
